

What is a codicil?

A codicil is an addition or change to your Will. If you would like to add a simple bequest for a specified amount you can fill out the details here. A codicil can be completed at any time and, like a Will, it becomes a legal document when signed in the presence of two adults who, at your request and in the presence of each other, add their names as witnesses. The codicil should remain with your Will at all times and be kept in a safe place. Please complete the form overleaf.

<u>Useful information</u>

The following notes might be helpful to you:

- 1. Fill in your name and address together with the amount of the legacy in the relevant space. Do not sign or date the codicil at this point.
- Find two adults to act as witnesses. They may be related to one another but not related to the writer of the Will nor to any of the Will's beneficiaries.
- 3. In the presence of your witnesses, insert the date of the codicil and sign your name.
- 4. In the presence of each other and you, the witnesses must sign the codicil and state their name, address and occupation.
- 5. Keep the codicil form in a safe place with your Will, but do not staple or pin it to the Will.
